Every year, the federal government provides billions of dollars in Title 1 funding for school districts to create and support education programs targeting disadvantaged students. Understanding that parent involvement is critical for enhancing student achievement and meeting the requirements of NCLB, the federal government recently awarded a one percent grant of total Title 1 funding to create programs between the school system and home. Unfortunately, if schools do not use the Title 1 dollars to provide a true "school-to-home connection" each year, the funding must be returned to the federal government.

1. For Students: Licenses for MY Access!®

MY Access![®] is aligned with state standards and offers links to other essential resources for educators, students, and parents. Since MY Access![®] is a Web-based program, it can be used at home, at the library, in after-school programs, or in the classroom–anywhere there is a computer with Internet access.

2. For Teachers: Learning to Use MY Access!® Workshop

If the participating school or district is a new user of MY Access![®], the Growing Together program includes Training Workshop #601. This session walks educators through the features and functions of MY Access![®], providing participants with an overview of the program from the perspective of both a teacher and a student.

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3. For Parents: Workshops for Helping Your Child be Successful at School

Each two-hour session is offered either on-site or via the Internet on evenings or weekends. Additional workshops may be conducted if requested by the participating school or district.
